#### **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:**

- ALWAYS disconnect the battery earth leads (before check the radio code if it's available)
- DO NOT turn crankshaft or camshaft with the timing belt/chain removed.
- Remove spark plugs to make the engine turn easier.
- ALWAYS turn the engine in the normal direction of rotation (unless otherwise stated).
- Mark the position of the crankshaft position sensor before disassembly (If it's supplied).
- NEVER turn the crankshaft via camshaft or other gears.
- ALWAYS observe all tightening torques.
- NEVER use cleaning fluids on belts, sprockets or rollers.
